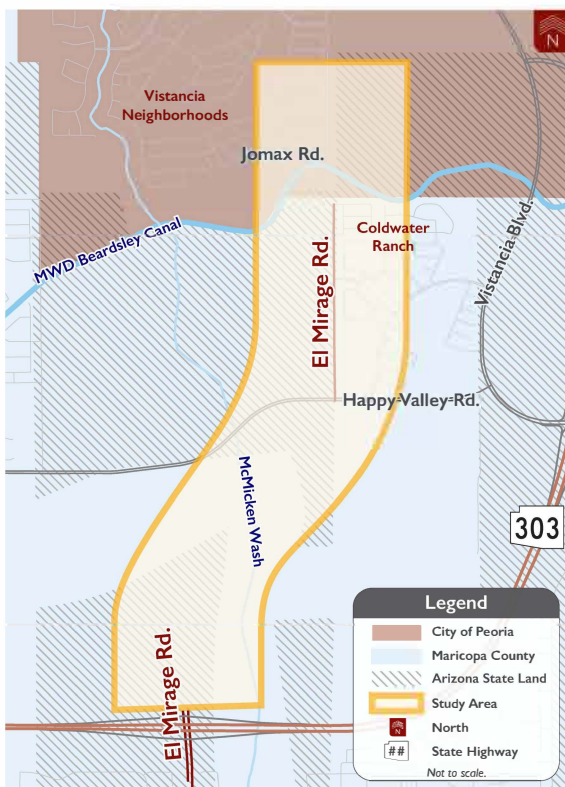
Fieldwork set to begin as part of the El Mirage Road: Loop 303 to Jomax Road study

Some residents might see crews, equipment nearby

Noise studies and geotechnical investigations are among the environmental fieldwork expected to begin later this month as part of the project to prepare a Design Concept Report (DCR) and Environmental Assessment (EA) for proposed improvements to El Mirage Road between Loop 303 and Jomax Road.

Some residents might see field crews and equipment in areas near their homes, but crews will not access individual private properties. All fieldwork will occur during daytime hours.

Noise specialists are expected to begin gathering noise-level readings from multiple locations in and around the study area in mid-to-late November. At the Beardsley Canal and McMicken Wash, crews will temporarily use drilling rigs to collect samples of underground materials for the geotechnical analysis used in the design of the crossings. Specific dates for this work have not been set.
